
CRITERIA FOR IDENTIFYING "CLOSE CONTACTS" TO A CONFIRMED CASE

If a student, teacher or caregiver is diagnosed with Covid-19 the school will expedite actions to identify people who could or will be classified as a "close contact". Close contacts will be required to immediately enter a 14-day self-isolation period. If they are staff or students, they will not be permitted back to school until the 14-day self-isolation period has ceased. Close Contacts are **currently** defined below. The close contact definition may change depending on the nature and evolving status of the virus.



Close Contact

A close contact is defined as any person with the following exposure to the case during the case's infectious period, without appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE).

At this point this criterion is predominantly for surveillance purposes.

CLASSIFICATIONS OF CLOSE CONTACTS CASES

To reduce the risk of further infection contacts will be expected to stay at home and avoid contact with others for a recommended period. This period will be set by health officials and is not at the discretion of KingsWay School. It is presently 14 days of self-isolation for those established as close contacts. It will be assumed that during this period of self-isolation close contacts will be tested to identify if they are carrying the Covid-19 virus. Once testing has occurred, they will be placed into one of 5 categories.
